

Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) Graduation & Placement Rates

Omega School submits its annual report to MHEC each October. MHEC determines the graduation rate as the number of completers divided by the number of Exited. MHEC explanation of data

Enrolled: students in attendance as of 7/1/18 to 6/30/19

Exited: withdrawals and graduates enrolled as of 7/1 with a last day of attendance between 7/1 & 6/30

Complt: students in attendance 7/1/18 to 6/30/19 – LOA, withdrawals, and students still enrolled as of 6/30/19

Cmpl % = $\text{complt} \div \text{exited} \times 100$

Empl: graduates employed in training related occupations

Empl%: $\text{Empl} \div \text{complt} \times 100$
